I'm planning this Paris Adventure from Wednesday, October 12th to Tuesday, October 18th with the option to extend your trip for another two or three days. I'm excited to be traveling to France in October instead of September. The weather will be crisp and cool, perfect for sightseeing. September was actually too hot at times for me.

DETAILS:

I'll be renting an apartment for the group, maximum of six people for the week, minimum of one person. Bedrooms and bathrooms will be shared by the group.

If the group consists of only one or two people, they will stay with me in my two-bedroom, two bath apartment in the 11th arrondissement and the cost will be reduced by \$200. For three or more people I'll be renting you your own

apartment. Trust me, you will love staying in an apartment versus a hotel. You'll feel like you live in Paris when you can walk to the corner boulangerie to buy your croissants and baguette each day or when you're shopping with the locals at the weekly Bastille market.

The itinerary for each week will be customized around the interests of my guests. Each morning I'll spend time with the group in activities such as visiting different arrondissements (neighborhoods), walking tours based on history, food, gardens, fashion, etc., visiting museums, markets and more. You'll have free time in the afternoon and then I'll meet you back at the apartment for wine & appetizers. We'll chat about your experiences that day and plan for the next day. After that you'll be free to go to dinner on your own or with others in the group. I'll be making some restaurant recommendations, suggesting some of my favorites and make reservations if needed. You'll always be able to reach me by phone and the schedule is definitely flexible with the exception of tours already booked.

The cost for each week will be \$2,200. AIRLINE TICKETS ARE NOT INCLUDED.

The price will include the following:

- Apartment rental
- Museum tickets/passes
- Metro tickets & maps
- 2 walking tours, including chocolate tasting.
- Transport from/to airport
- Evening wine and appetizers
- First night's welcome dinner
- Last night's farewell dinner
- Fresh croissants/pastries for breakfast
- Beginning staples for the apartment
- Evening dinner cruise on the Seine
- Fashion Show
- Maps/plan books of the Paris neighborhoods

Optional activities for an additional cost might include a cooking lesson, visits to Giverney or Versailles, etc.
